

A&E Artists to Watch

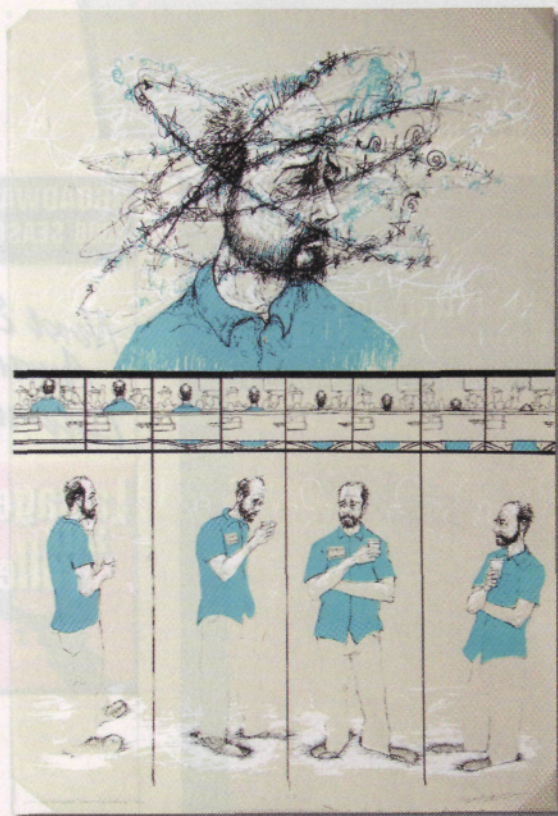
• ELAINE GREENE

DARA ALLISON HARVEY •

A prolific painter, Dara Allison Harvey's pop surrealist style and densely layered color work result in works like **"BIRD FEEDER."** Harvey, who teaches at Spokane Art School, describes her imagery as a blend of anthropomorphism and random or impulsive selection, resulting in "deliberate, whimsical and often disturbing" work that can even remind you of Hieronymous Bosch.



SCOTT KOLBO •

An innovative printmaker, Scott Kolbo's extensive drawing background combines with his interest in examining culture, religious faith, aesthetics and media. Kolbo, who teaches at Whitworth College, developed the character in the screenprint **"HEAVY MAN STRUGGLES"** as an alter-ego of sorts who struggles with life and self-doubt in the contemporary world.
